

## SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

School uniform is compulsory for all students in Year 7-12.

Parents/carers need to ensure students are wearing correct uniform. If students are to be out of uniform, they should be given a note explaining why this is necessary which is used to obtain a Uniform Pass from an Assistant Principal before 9:00am. Failure to carry a note may lead to a lunch time detention.

Correct school uniform should be worn to and from school, at school, and on school excursions. Students seen outside the school in school uniform ought to behave in a manner that enhances the school's reputation in the community. Uniform worn incorrectly (e.g. without shoes), leaves as much of a bad impression as unseemly behaviour. We expect to have parent and student support in ensuring that uniform is worn to the advantage of the school reputation.

## STUDENT PRESENTATION

All students should be presented in a neat and tidy manner.

School policy states that extreme hair styles or extensive jewellery are not acceptable at Oberon High School.

Jewellery should be kept to a minimum and should not be of a type that could cause injury. Earrings should be either sleepers or studs. One simple ring is allowed. Necklaces and chains should not be visible.
