## Year 9 GERMAN

Year 9 students must complete two units of the LANGUAGE they have been studying in Years 7 and 8. Students will complete the Year 9 GERMAN course according to the Victorian Curriculum which will allow them to elect to continue with their German at Year 10.

Throughout the year the aim is to develop students' knowledge, skills and confidence in language learning and its use, by speaking, listening, reading and writing. Students do this through role plays, recitation, conversations, class discussions, vocabulary and grammar learning, listening and comprehension exercises and reading texts. The focus is on communication and gaining intercultural knowledge.

Students will have the wonderful opportunity to apply to participate in the 5 week Sister School Trip to Marburg in Germany.
